



# KANGAROO FLAT BOWLS CLUB POLICY – CONTROLLING BODY

Responsible Officer; Director Bowls (Weekend/Midweek)

## 1 PREAMBLE AND RATIONALE

The Controlling Body is the club on whose green Pennant is being played on that day. The controlling body has immediate control over the Conditions of Play under which the game is played.

In most situations the side managers and umpires of the day make most of the decisions and this would always remain the case.

## 2 APPOINTMENT OF CONTROLLING BODY

The KFBC Selection Committee will nominate a person to be the controlling body for the day. This person shall not be the umpire or side manager for that day.

## 3 CONDITIONS OF PLAY

The person nominated as the Controlling Body shall have a sound understanding of the Conditions of Play under which the game is being played.

## 4 CONTROLLING BODY RESPONSIBILITIES

The person nominated as the Controlling Body will also act as the Greens Director for the day.

The Controlling body will manage and implement the Conditions of Play. This may include the following responsibilities:

- Suspending play if necessary due to weather or other conditions;
- Approving the introduction and eligibility of a substitute;
- Management of pre-game practice;
- Initiate appeals to the Umpires regarding damage to greens;
- Collecting the bowls and deposit in the event of a challenge to bowls;
- Receiving complaints against an umpire's decision;
- Approve the carrying of a personal electronic device;
- Acting against spectators that are in breach of the laws;
- Appealing to the umpire to apply an instantaneous penalty for noncompliance with provisions relating to conduct & behaviour, smoking, personal electronic devices, or consumption of alcohol.
- Appeal to the umpire to enforce conditions of play for a player causing damage to the Green.
